ORDER

The City of Madera is authorized to construct South "E" Street at grade across tracks of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Madera, Madera County, at the locations described in the application as southeast of 11th Street and northwest of 9th Street to be identified as Crossings Nos. B-184.5-C and B-184.1-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossings shall be not less than twenty-four feet and grades of approach not greater than two percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signs or two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B), equipped with reflex-reflective sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
