ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct two side tracks at grade across an unnamed roadway in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6LDB-1.47. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding six per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material. Upon completion of the additional tracks, no cars shall be stored within 80 feet of the paved area on any of the tracks.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
