- A. All points in the Los Angeles Territory as more particularly described in Appendix B attached hereto.
- B. The Los Angeles Drayage Area (Zones 1-A, 1-B, 1-C, 1-D, 10, 11, 12 and 17 as described in Items Nos. 30, 31, 32 and 33 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 of the Public Utilities Commission, as in effect on the date of the decision noted in the margin), on the one hand, and Arcadia, Glendora, Monrovia, Covina, Pomona, Ontario, Upland, Pedley, Fontana, San Bernardino and Riverside, on the other hand.
- C. The Los Angeles Drayage Area (Zones 1-A, 1-B, 1-C, 1-D, 10, 11, 12 and 17 as described in Items Nos. 30, 31, 32 and 33 of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 5 of the Public Utilities Commission, as in effect on the date of the decision noted in the margin), on the one hand, and Artesia, Garden Grove, Anaheim, Santa Ana, Bellflower, Fullerton and Norwalk, on the other hand.

Applicant shall not transport any shipments of:

- 1. Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A.
- 2. Automobiles, Trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.

Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine. 4. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment. 5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.

- 6. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
- 7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.

The authority set forth in paragraphs B and C above do not include the right to render service to, from or between intermediate points.

Applicant shall not establish through routes and joint rates, charges and classifications as to the separate authorities hereinabove set forth at paragraphs A, B and C.
