O R D E R

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company filed on December 24, 1956 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Fairville during the past three years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Fairville, County of Sonoma; to remove a spur track at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised

within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
