O R D E R

Los Angeles and Salt Lake Railroad and its lessee, Union Pacific Railroad Company, are authorized to construct an additional spur track at grade across Noakes Street in Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 3-3.58-C. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent. Protection shall be by one additional Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B), in the northeast quadrant. Applicants shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicants shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

It is alleged that the industry to be served by this spur is in need of immediate service.

Therefore the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
