OPINION AND ORDER

Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, by the above-entitled application filed January 7, 1957, seeks authorization of this Commission to carry out the terms of an unexecuted agreement, to become effective for the period January 1 to December 31, 1957, with Joseph Augustus Rafferty and Marilyn Helon Rafferty, his wife, permitting them to take not to exceed 65,340 cubic feet of water per year, but not in excess of 179 cubic feet of water in any 24-hour period, of surface flow from Santa Paula Creek for garden purposes. The price to be paid for the right to take water is \$45.31 per year. The agreement is to expire on December 31, 1957, unless extended by mutual agreement of the parties in writing prior to said expiration date, subject to further authorization by this Commission.

A prior agreement, similar except for executed and expiration dates, was approved by this Commission in its Decision No. 52399, dated December 28, 1955, in Application No. 37516.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, be authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the agreement with Joseph Augustus Rafferty and Marilyn Helen
