ORDER OF SUSPENSION

It has been called to the Commission's attention that Joseph E. Bosso, doing business as the Acme Cab Company and presently authorized to operate a passenger stage service between Watsonville Airport and Santa Cruz, discontinued service because his revenue for 1956 amounted to \$16. Because he is of the belief that a need for such service may exist in the future he has requested that he be permitted to retain his certificate.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that such operating authority be suspended to and including February 15, 1958.

Therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the operating authority created by Decision No. 43849 dated February 20, 1950 in Application No. 30989, is suspended to and including February 15, 1958.

2. That Joseph E. Bosso shall amend the tariffs and timetables presently on file with this Commission in his name to reflect the authority herein granted.
