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Parker Truck Company is engaged in the transportarion of property in California pursuant to permits issuod by this Commission. Applicant seeks an order authorizing it to conduct service as a highway comon carnier for the transportation of comoditios betwoen the Los Angeles and San Diego Territories; the Los Angeles Territory and Fresno; points in the Imperial Valley Territory; Sacramento and points on T. S. Eighmay NO. 99 botwoon tho Los AncolesKem County line and Sacramonto; San Franciseo Territory and points on J. S. Eighray No. 101 between Los Angeles-Ventura County line; and between Pomona and San Diego Forritory, including intemediate and offrroute points.

Notice of filing of the application was given all common corriers subject to the jurisciction of this Commission.

Jpon consideration of the allegations of the application, the representations ified pursuant to the above-mentionod notice and the evidence adduced at the boaring, the Comission finds that public convenience and necessity require that the application be granted to the extent set forth in the ensuing order. It appears that applicant possesses the experience, equipment, personnel anc financial resources to institute and maintain the operation authorized horein.

Appifcant is hereby pascec on notice that operative rights, es suck, do not constitute a class of property which may be capitalized or used as an eloment of value in rate fixing for any amount of money in excess of that originaily paid to the State as the consiceration for the grant of such rights. Aside from their purely permissive aspect, such rifhts extend to the boldor a full or partial monopoly of a class of business over a particuiar route. This monopoly feature may be changed or destroyed at any time by the State, which is not in any respect inmitei as to the number of sights wific may be givan.

A pubiic hoaring having been held and besed upon the ovidence adduced therein and the application and representations filed hereir,

II IS ORDERED:
(i) That a cortiricato of public convenience and necessity is granted to Parker Truck Company, a corporation, authorizing it to operate as a highway common carrier as deinined by Section 213 of the Public Jtilities Code for the twansportation of property botweon the points and over the routes as rore particulariy set forth in Appendix A and Appendix $B$ attacied hereto and made a part heroof.
(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
(a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate heroin granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will bo required, among other things, to lie annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety males and other regulations of the Commission's General order No. 99. Failure to fie such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 99, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority Exantod by this decision.
(b) Within sixty days after tho effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service heroin authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.
The effective date of this order shall be ninety days
after the date hereof.

Parker Truck Company, a corporation, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision notec in the margin, is authorizec to transport property betweon the Ios Angeles Temitory and the San Diego Territory (each tomitory as more partiauianiy described in Appendix B atteched hereto) and intemecinate points via J. S. Hizaways Nos. 101 and 101-A; proviced, however, appicant shall not rendor local service between ony two points, both of which ife nortin of ocemside.

The authorization berefnabove set forth is limited to the transportation of property to or from setail grocery ostablishments.

Applicant shall not transport any ohipments of:

1. Used housebold scods and personal effects not packed in accorciance with the crated property roquinements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. IO-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. $4-A$.

2n Automobiles, trucks and buses, $\nabla 1 z .:$ new and used, rinisied or unfinished passenger automobiles (inciuding jeops), ambuisnces, hearses and taxis; froight automobilos, automobilo chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailors, trucks and trailors combined, buses amd bus chassis.
3. Livestock, $71 z_{0}=$ bucks, bulls, calves, cattie, cows, dairy cattie, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, $2 a m b s, o x e n$, pigs, sheep, sheop camp outift 3, sows, steers, stags or swine.

6. Commodities when trancportod in buik in dup trucks or in hoppor-type trucks.

IOS ANGELES TERRITORY inciudes that area embraced by the following bouncary: Beginning at the intersection of Sunset Boulovard and U. S. Highway No. 101, Altornato; thonce northoasterly on Sunsot Eoulevard to State lighway No. 7; northeriy along State Highway No. 7 to State Eighway No. 118; nowtheasterly along State Iighway No. 118 through and including the City of San Femando; continuing northoasterly and soutbeasterly
 Pasadena; easterly along U. S. Eighway No. 66 to State Eighway No. 19; southeriy alons State Eighmay No. 19 to Lowor Azuca Road; eastoriy on Lower dzusa Foad to its intorsection with tho San Gabriel River; southeriy along the west bank of tho San Gabriol River to Beveniy Boulevard; southeasteriy on Zeverly Boulevard to Painter Avenue in the City of Whittier; southerly on Painter Avenue to State Eighway No. 26; westeriy along State Highway No. 26 to the west bank of the San Gabriel River; southerly aiong the wost bank of tine San Gabriel Rivor to Imperial Highway; westeriy on Imperial Eighmay to State Iighway No. 19; southeriy elong state Eighway No. 29 to ite intersection with U. S. Eighway No. 101, Alternato, at Ximeno Street; southerly along Ximeno Stroet and its prolongation to the Paciric occan; westeriy and northeriy along the shore line of the Pacific Ocean to a point directiy south of the intersection of Sunset Boulevard and J. S. Highway No. 101, Altormate; thence northeriy aiong an imaginary iine to point of beginning.

SAN DIEAO RERRTMORY inciudos that anoa ombraced by the foilowing imaginary ine starting at the northeriy jumetion of J. S. Highways 101-E and 101-W (four miles north of La Joila); thence easterly to Miramar on State Aigimay No. 395; thence southeasterly to Lakosice on the EI Cajon-Ramona Eighmay; thence southeriy to Bostonia on J. S. Eighway No. 80; thence southeasteriy to Jamul on State Eighway No. 94; thence due south to the International Boundary Iine; west to the Pacific Ocean and north along the coast to point of beginning.
