Highway No. 395 to Alessandro; westerly aiong umnemed county road to Arlington; southwesteriy aiong State Elghway No. 18 to J. S. Eiginay No. 91; westoriy alons J. S. Eigmay No. 91 to State Eignway No. 55; southeriy along state Eighway No. 55 to the Pacilic Occan; wost exly and northeriy along the chome ine of the paciric Ocean to a point eirectiy south of the intersoction of Sunset Boulevand and U.S. Eighway No. 101, aitemate; thence northeriy along an imaginary line to point or beginning.

Included within the ternitory zmediatoly above described are all places within the comporate ifmits of any city which is bisected by the State and J. S. Eighways and county roads constituting the boundary or such tempitory betwoen Yucalpa and Nowport Beach.
