O P I N I O N

Key System Transit Lines, presently rendering a passenger service between and in the various communities of the East Bay Area in the County of Alameda and County of Contra Costa, and between said counties and the City and County of San Francisco, requests authority to extend a portion of its No. 15A Charleston and Laguna Avenues line to the newly constructed out-patient clinic of Highland Hospital.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that the extension would amount to approximately two blocks; that some 135,000 patient visits are made annually to the present out-patient clinic and that the proposed extension will facilitate and aid many patients who would otherwise have to walk approximately 1,250 feet to the new location, all of which would be on an ascending grade.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary. Because the new out-patient clinic will be opened on March 4, 1957, the effective date of this order will be made the date hereof.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Key System Transit Lines authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers over and along the following streets in the City of Oakland:

Along Vallecito Place between 14th Avenue and East 31st Street.
Along East 31st Street between Vallecito Place and 14th Avenue.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall file a written acceptance thereof within thirty days after the effective date hereof.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
