## ORDER

The City of Coronado is authorized to construct "A"

Avenue at grade along the Coronado Branch of San Diego & Arizona

Eastern Railway Company in the City of Coronado, San Diego County,

at the location described in the application, to be identified

as Crossing No. 36C-20.41. Applicant shall bear entire con
struction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two

feet outside of rails. San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway

Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width

of highway which forms the crossing shall be not less than 48

feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent.

Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of

General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1

crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting

sheet material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing.

This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
