(1) That ordering paragraph (3) of Decision No. 54241, issued herein on December 11, 1956, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(3) That the operating authority now held by applicant is hereby revoked and cancelled to the extent that such presently held operating authority is duplicated by the authority granted herein. Such revocation and cancellation shall take effect simultaneously with the institution of service under the authority granted herein.

(2) That Decision No. 54241 is further amended by substituting First Revised Page 2 of Appendix A, attached hereto, to said decision in the place and stead of Original Page 2 of Appendix A thereto.

- 2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses and bus chassis.
- 3. Livestock, viz.: bucks, bulls, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, goats, hogs, horses, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags or swine.
- Commodities requiring the use of special refrig-4. eration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerated equipment.
- 5. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semi-plastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles.
- Commodities when transported in bulk in dump 6. trucks or in hopper-type trucks.
- 7. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
 - Note: The above exceptions (paragraphs Nos. 1 through 7) do not apply to transportation performed under the unrevoked portions of operating rights held by Boulevard prior to December 11, 1956. Such prior authority includes but is not limited to that created by the following decisions:
