ORDER OF REVOCATION

Kit Carson Stages, a corporation, at the present time is the owner of certificates of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to serve as a passenger stage corporation, for the transportation of passengers and baggage and shipments of express weighing 150 pounds or less, between Jackson, Martell, Electra Powerhouse, Pine Grove, Pioneer Station, West Point, Buckhorn, Bartons, Tiger Creek, Salt Springs, the various construction camps on the Mokelumne River Hydroelectric Development Project and intermediate points and between Bartons and Silver Creek and intermediate points. These certificates were granted by Decision No. 42025 dated September 3, 1948 in Application No. 29602, Decision No. 42406 dated January 4, 1949 in Application No. 29602, and Decision No. 44332 dated June 20, 1950 in Application No. 31432.

All of the operations except the one between Bartons and Silver Lake were conducted on an "on call" basis. The Commission in its Decision No. 51771 dated August 1, 1955, authorized the temporary suspension of the operation between Bartons and Silver Lake until August 1, 1956. Prior to that time this particular operation was

conducted as a scheduled service during the period from approximately June 15 to September 15 of each year.

The Transportation Division reports that this corporation has not resumed service on its Bartons-Silver Lake operation and that it is not conducting any operations whatsoever at the present time.

In view of the foregoing circumstances, the Commission finds that Kit Carson Stages has discontinued and abandoned the passenger stage operations above described without first having obtained appropriate authority therefor.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience and necessity created by Decision No. 42025 dated September 3, 1948 in Application No. 29602, Decision No. 42406 dated January 4, 1949 in Application No. 29602, and Decision No. 44332 dated June 20, 1950 in Application No. 31432, are hereby revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission in the name of Kit Carson Stages are hereby canceled.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served upon Kit Carson Stages in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon Kit Carson Stages unless Kit Carson Stages before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event

the effective date of this order shall hereby be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
