## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The applicant having filed its petition on November 27, 1956 seeking modification and reconsideration or rehearing of the Commission's Decision No. 53223, dated June 12, 1956, herein, the Commission having considered the same and being of the opinion and finding that public convenience and necessity require that such petition be granted to the extent hereinafter set forth,

Now Therefore, IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Decision No. 53223, issued herein on June 12, 1956, be, and it is, amended by substituting First Revised Pages 1 and 2 of Appendix A, each of which is attached hereto in the place and stead of Original Pages 1 and 2 of Appendix A as attached to said Decision No. 53223.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate extension herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

> (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's

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General Order No. 99. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 99, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

(b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than ten days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

(3) That, in all other respects, said Decision No. 53223, as amended, shall romain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.

Willig Freight Lines (a corporation)

First Revised Page 1 Cancels Original Page 1

Willig Freight Lines, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport general commodities between all points and places on or within three miles laterally of:

- (1) State Highway No. 1 between Rockport and Valley Ford and intermediate points;
- (2) U.S. Highway No. 101 between Cloverdale and San Francisco and intermediate points;
- (3) State Highway No. 12 between Monte Rio and Schellville and intermediate points;
- (4) State Highway 37 between Schellville and junction U. S. Highway No. 101 and intermediate points;
- (5) Unnumbered highways between Valley Ford, Sebastopol, Monte Rio, Occidental, Graton, Fulton, Hilton, Armstrong State Park, Annapolis and Skaggs Springs;
- (6) Between San Francisco Territory as described in Appendix B attached hereto, Martinez, Sacramento, Stockton, Modesto, Los Banos, Merced, Fresno, Tulare, Bakersfield and points which applicant is presently authorized to serve south and east of Bakersfield; and
  - Noto: The authority conferred by paragraph (6) above does not include the right to serve intermediate points.
- (7) Between all points and places set forth in numbers
  (1) thru (5), on the one hand, and all points set
  forth in paragraph (6), on the other hand.

Willig Freight Lines (a corporation)

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Applicant shall not transport any shipmonts of:

- (a) Used household goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A;
- (b) Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers or a combination of such highway vehicles;
- (c) Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit; and
- (d) Articles of extraordinary value.

Applicant shall conduct operations over and along any and all streets, roads and highways including, but not limited to, the ones enumerated herein.

All operating authority possessed by this applicant, on the date hereof, which authorizes transportation also authorized herein shall be deemed to have merged with the authority herein granted as of the date when service hereunder is actually begun.

Nothing in this order shall be construed to revoke any operating authority now possessed by applicant except as set forth in the next preceding paragraph hereof.
