ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that by Commission Decision No. 44375 dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31044, H. R. Nelson was authorized to establish and operate a service as a petroleum irregular route carrier throughout the State for the transportation of petroleum and petroleum products in tank trucks and tank trailers, pursuant to the provisions of Section 50 3/4 of the Public Utilities Act, as amended by Statutes 1949, Chapter 1399; and that pursuant to the authority contained in Decision No. 52456 dated January 9, 1956, in Application No. 37519, these operative rights were assigned and transferred to Frank Wilkinson, Jr., and Fred McDonald, copartners, doing business as Supreme Tank Line, and it further appearing that said partnership was dissolved on December 15, 1956, and that all operations as a petroleum irregular route carrier have now ceased and the partners have no insurance on file with the Commission, it having been canceled on January 21, 1957; therefore, it is found that Frank Wilkinson, Jr., and Fred McDonald, copartners, are no longer conducting and have discontinued and abandoned said petroleum irregular route operations, and that they should be required to have their participation in the agency tariff to which they are a party canceled.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to H. R. Nelson by said Decision No. 44375 and

acquired by Frank Wilkinson, Jr., and Fred McDonald, pursuant to said Decision No. 52456 is hereby revoked; and that they are hereby directed to cause to be canceled, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, their participation in tariffs naming rates and rules governing the operation herein involved.

The Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served upon said Frank Wilkinson, Jr., and Fred McDonald.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof on said Frank Wilkinson, Jr., and Fred McDonald unless they, before such effective date, shall have filed with the Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order will be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
