Pacisic Greyhound Ines requests authority to operate over an alternate route between Grant Inne Road Junction on U. S. Eighway 99 and Bradshaw Road Junction on T. S. \#ighway 50.

As justification for the authority sought, applicant aileges that the proposed alternate route would be used primarily for the prorpose of transporting passengers, particulariy on week ends, between Stockton and the southern Lake rahoe resort area; that the proposed aiternate route would materially reduce the bus miles and the elapsed time in transit as well as alleviate the necessity of traveling through the City of Sacramento.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion and so Ifinds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be nocessary.

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Application having been filed, the Comission having been informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That a certificate of pubilc convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Greyhound Ines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage
corporation, as that tem is defined in Section 226 of the Publie Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the route set forth in Route No. 3.17 appearing on Fourth Revised Page 14 of Appendix A, attacied hereto, as an extension and eniargement of, and consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in tho certificate granted by Decision No. 47907 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.
(2) That Appendix A of Decision No. 47907 is hereby amended by incorporating Fourth Revised Page 14.
(3) That in providing service pursuant to the certirfcate heroin granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
(a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant sheil file a written acceptance of the certificate hereln granted.
(b) Within sixty days after the effective date bereof and on not Iess than Ive days: notice to the Commission and to the public, appiicant sheli establish the service herein authorized and file, in tripilcate and concurrentiy make effectivo, appropriate tarifis and timetables.
The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after
the date hereof.
