<u>OPINION</u>

Pacific Greyhound Lines requests authority to revise its urban routes in the City of Davis.

As justification for the authority sought, applicant alleges that the revision of routes is made necessary by the fact that its passenger station within the City of Davis has been relocated from G and Fourth Streets to G and Second Streets.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed, the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Pacific Greyhound Lines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the points and over the routes set forth in Routes Nos. UR-2.01, UR-2.02 and UR-2.03 appearing on Second Revised Page 66 of Appendix A, attached hereto, as an extension and enlargement of, and consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in

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the certificate granted by Decision No. 47907, and in particular, subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix A thereof.

2. That Appendix A of Decision No. 47907 is hereby amended by incorporating Second Revised Page 66.

3. That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, appropriate tariffs and timetables.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
