O P I N I O N

Bend-Portland Truck Service, Inc. requests authority to transport general commodities as a highway common carrier between Alturas and the California-Oregon border and intermediate points.

As justification for the authority sought applicant alleges that it is presently certificated by the Interstate Commerce Commission to provide service between Lakeview, and other points in Oregon, on the one hand, and Alturas on the other hand; and that as an incident to such service it has received many requests for the proposed intrastate operation.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises:

IT IS ORDERED

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Bend-Portland Truck Service, Inc., authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code for

the transportation of general commodities between Alturas and the California-Oregon border and intermediate points via U. S. Highway 395.

(2) That in providing this service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective appropriate tariffs.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
