O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company has filed application to abandon its non-agency station at Peacock, Alameda County. The company states that a new Class "A" non-agency station named Snoboy, 0.4 mile south of Peacock Station will be established.

Good cause appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Peacock, County of Alameda; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such abandonment shall not be made until the establishment of Snoboy Station. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not

exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
