Decision No. 54765

BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of the PETALUMA AND SANTA ROSA RAILROAD COMPANY for authority (a) to abandon its Class "B" non-agency station of Liberty, in the County of Sonoma, State of California, and to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 514 feet in length located at said non-agency station; (b) to abandon its Class "B" non-agency station of Stony Point, in the County of Sonoma, State of California, and to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 558 feet in length located at said non-agency station; (c) to abandon its Class "B" non-agency station of Llano, in the County of Sonoma, State of California, and to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 510 feet in length located at said non-agency station, and (d) to abandon its Class "B" non-agency station of Taylor in the County of Sonoma, State of California, and to abandon and remove a spur track approximately 400 feet in length located at said station.

ORDER

The verified application of Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company filed on January 29, 1957 discloses that no passenger or freight business has been transacted at applicant's stations of Liberty, Stony Point, Llano and Taylor during the past three years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good cause appearing, Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency stations of Liberty, Stony Point, Llano and Taylor, County of Sonoma; to remove spur tracks at said stations as set forth in the application; to eliminate said names from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said stations on not less than five days: notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority, This order

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shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
