ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing by Commission Decision No. 51130 dated February 23, 1955, in the above proceeding, that Willis E. Huffman was authorized to establish and operate a service as a passenger stage corporation for the transportation of passengers between Hemet and Idyllwild, California; that said Willis E. Huffman by letter, received by the Commission on February 20, 1957, stated that he is unable to continue this operation and wishes authority to permit him to stop operating because of illness; therefore, it is found that Willis E. Huffman is no longer conducting and has discontinued said passenger stage operation.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued to Willis E. Huffman is revoked and all effective tariffs and timetables on file in the name of Willis E. Huffman are hereby cancelled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served upon said Willis E. Huffman.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon Willis E. Huffman, unless said Willis E. Huffman before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a response to this order denying the

facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon,
in which event the effective date of this order will thereby be
stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
