OPINION AND ORDER

This Commission having issued Docision No. 54306, dated December 21, 1956, in Application No. 37856, and therein having granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to the applicant to construct and operate a public utility water system subject to the following condition:

That applicant shall install and place in operation reservoir or storage capacity of not less than 120,000 gallons for its Desert Braemar area, within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and chall notify the Commission within ten days after such facilities are placed in operation,

and applicant now alleging that it is securing additional data as to a further source of water supply and also as to fire protection facilities, which data is not now of record in these proceedings and which may affect the requirement for a reservoir, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the time set out in the aforementioned condition shall be extended for an additional sixty days so that the condition shall read as follows:

That applicant shall install and place in operation reservoir or storage capacity of not less than

120,000 gallons for its Desert Braemar area, within one hundred twenty days after the effective date hereof, and shall notify the Commission within ten days after such facilities are placed in operation.
