ORDER

state of California, Department of Public Works, is authorized to widen and reconstruct State Route 1 (U.S. 101) at separated grades over a main line track and a spur track of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, near San Rafael, Marin County, at the locations as shown by map (Exhibit B) attached to the application as amended, being identified as Crossings Nos. 5-15.7-A and 5-16.2-AC, respectively. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossings approved by Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of G.O. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
