## ORDER

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct an entrance to the Silver Strand Beach State Park at grade across the Coronado Branch of San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company in the County of San Diego, at the location described in Exhibit "B" of the application as amended January 31, 1957, to be identified as Crossing No. 36C-15.2. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 foot and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material. Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties, and a copy of said executedagreement shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing construction. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order.

Upon completion of Crossing No. 36C-15.2 and its being opened to travel, Silver Strand Park Drive (Crossing No. 36C-15.4) shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

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
