## BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of  
WILLIAM BOSTWICK, an individual doing  
business as BOSTWICK LUMBER TRANSPOR-  
TATION, to sell and AL MATTSON, an in-  
dividual, to purchase a highway common  
carrier certificate between various points  
in Central and Northern California.

ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 44936, dated October 24, 1950, in Appli-  
cation No. 31806, Al Mattson, doing business as Mattson Lumber  
Transportation, was authorized to acquire a certificate of public  
convenience and necessity from one William Bostwick. This certificate  
had been issued to William Bostwick by this Commission in Decision  
No. 43424, dated October 18, 1949, in Application No. 29792. This  
certificate authorized the transportation of lumber and other forest  
products between various points in Central and Northern California.

The Transportation Division reports that on January 1, 1956,  
Mattson sold his lumber trucking business to R & G Lumber Company  
and that he is now engaged in another form of business.

In view of the foregoing circumstances, the Commission finds  
that Al Mattson, doing business as Mattson Lumber Transportation, has  
discontinued and abandoned the highway common carrier operations  
above-described without first having obtained appropriate authority  
therefor, and that he should be required to have his participation in  
the agency tariff to which he is a party canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience  
and necessity created by Decision No. 43424, dated October 18, 1949,  
in Application No. 29792 and authorized to be transferred in Decision

No. 44936, dated October 24, 1950, in Application No. 31806, is hereby revoked and that Al Mattson is hereby directed to cause to be canceled, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and public, his participation in tariffs naming rates and rules governing the operations herein involved.

The Secretary of the Commission is hereby directed to cause a certified copy of this order to be served on Al Mattson in the manner prescribed by law.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after lawful service thereof upon Al Mattson unless Al Mattson before such effective date shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until a hearing is held and a further order is issued.
