O R D E R

The City of Sacramento is authorized to widen the crossing of 65th Street at grade with tracks of Southern Pacific Company, (Crossing No. AH-94.3) in the City of Sacramento, Sacramento County, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 58 feet and grades of approach not greater than three percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 8 crossing signals. (General Order No. 75-B).

Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety

so require. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
