In the Matter of the Application of E.L. CULVER, doing business as CULVER WAREHOUSE CO., to discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman and to cancel rates.

OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant has been conducting a public utility warehouse operation at Santa Ana since 1947. He handles only beans, grain and mill feeds. By this application he seeks authority to discontinue the operation and requests permission to cancel his Warehouse Tariff, C.R.C. No. 1.

The application states that at the present time there are no patrons using applicant's facilities and that there have been no storers for the past year. It also states that applicant has no demand for the service and that he does not anticipate any demand. It asserts further that adequate public utility warehouse facilities are available in the area involved and that no one will be adversely affected by the discontinuance of the warehouse.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary. The sought authority to discontinue service will be granted. Also, applicant's tariff on file with the Commission will be canceled.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that E.L. Culver, doing business as Culver Warehouse Co., be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue service as a public utility warehouseman at 1041 East Fourth Street, Santa Ana, and that his Warehouse Tariff, C.R.C. No. 1, be and it is hereby canceled.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
