Boginning at (and including) the City of Santa Barbara; thence along U. S. Highway No. 101 to the intersection thereof with State Highway No. 126; thence along State Highway No. 126 to its intersection with U. S. Highway No. 99; thence along U. S. Highway No. 99 to its first intersection with the corporate limits of the City of San Fernando; thence northerly along said corporate boundary to McClay Avenue; northeasterly along McClay Avenue and its prolongation to the Angeles National Forest boundary; southeasterly and easterly along the Angeles National Forest and San Bernardino National Forest boundary to the county read known as Mill Creek Read; westerly along Mill Creek Read to the county read 3.8 miles north of Yucaipa; southerly along said county read to and including the unincorporated community of Yucaipa; westerly along Redlands Boulevard to U. S. Highway No. 99; northwesterly along U. S. Highway No. 99 to and including the City of Redlands; westerly along U. S. Highway No. 395 to State Highway No. 395; southerly along U. S. Highway No. 395 to State Highway No. 55; southerly along U. S. Highway No. 18 to U. S. Highway No. 91; westerly along U. S. Highway No. 91 to State Highway No. 55; southerly on State Highway No. 55 to the City of Santa Ana; thence via U. S. Highway No. 101 to San Clemente (including the off-route point of El Tore Marino Base); thence southwesterly to the shore line of the Pacific Ocean; thence northwesterly along the shore line of the Pacific Ocean to the point of boginning.
