OPINION and ORDER

Charles F. Bellue filed the Commission's form application for a Radial Highway Common Carrier permit on August 27, 1956, giving his address as 9974 Alder Street, Bloomington, California.

A public hearing was held in Los Angeles before Examiner Mark V. Chiesa.

The record shows that applicant, Charles F. Bellue, was notified of said hearing by mailing of Notice of Hearing on April 4, 1957, to the address appearing in said application for permit. There was no appearance by or for applicant.

The Commission's records show and we find that in 1956 applicant and one James T. Moore, doing business as Banning Truck Lines, were issued a Radial Highway Common Carrier permit No. 33-2361, and that said permit was revoked by this Commission for failure to continue in effect during the life of said permit adequate accident liability insurance protection as required by Sections 3631, 3632 and 3634 of the Public Utilities Code.

The Commission also finds that applicant's financial responsibility cannot be determined from the information as set forth in paragraph 7 of his application for permit.

Therefore, it appearing that a prior permit issued to Charles F. Bellue, as a copartner of Banning Truck Lines, has been cancelled or revoked pursuant to Section 3774 of the Public Utilities Code and that the Commission is unable to find that applicant possesses the required financial responsibility to perform the operations proposed,

IT IS ORDERED that the application of Charles F. Bellue, doing business as Bellue Trucking, for a Radial Highway Common Carrier permit, Application No. 36-3444, File No. T-60,196 (formal Application No. 38673), be, and it hereby is, denied.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
