ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industrial drill track across Artesia Avenue (State Highway Route 175), in the vicinity of the City of Buena Park, in the Counties of Los Angeles and Orange, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BK-503.53-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 to a width of not less than 44 feet, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The industry to be served declares that it is urgently in need of rail service and requests that the Commission waive the usual 20-day clause. Therefore, the effective date of this order is the date hereof.
