ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that by Decision No. 38792, dated March 26, 1946, in Application No. 27250, Charles Pierson Slocombe was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment and operation as a common carrier for the transportation of persons and hand baggage by vessel between Long Beach and Avalon, on Catalina Island; and it further appearing that by Decision No. 38758, dated December 16, 1946, in Application No. 27250 and by Decision No. 40737, dated September 23, 1947, in Application No. 28723 suspensions of operations were authorized until May 1, 1948; and no further suspensions have been requested or granted and no further operations have been carried on by Charles Pierson Slocombe subsequent to May 1, 1948, therefore, it is found that Charles Pierson Slocombe is no longer conducting and has discontinued and abandoned operations under his operating authority.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Charles Pierson Slocombe by said Decision No. 38792 is hereby revoked and all effective timetables and tariffs on file in the name of Charles Pierson Slocombe are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served upon said Charles Pierson Slocombe.

The effective date of this order shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon said Charles Pierson Slocombe unless before such effective date he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order, denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
