ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an additional spur track, relocate four spur tracks and a drill track all at grade across Pearl Street and Blanding Avenue and to relocate a side track at grade across Clement Avenue in the City of Alameda, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-10.38-C and 10-0.1, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street and avenues now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding three percent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time

be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, ✓
or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after
the date hereof.
