FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 35100 the United States Government was authorized to construct a spur track at grade across U.S. Highway No. 66 and at two locations across Adelanto Road, a county road, in San Bernardino County, with protection at each of the three locations to be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B). Owing to changes in conditions at the two crossings of the county road, it now appears that the crossing protection should be revised.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the fourth sentence in the first paragraph of the order in Decision No. 35100, dated March 3, 1942, be amonded to read as follows:

Protoction at Crossing No. 2-35.1-C shall be by two Standard No. 3 crossing signals (General Order No. 75-B) and at Crossings Nos. 2-35.2-C and 2-38.3-C shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (Coneral Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

In all other respects, Decision No. 35100 shall remain in full force and effect.
