FOURTH INTERIM OPINION AND ORDER

Walkup Drayage & Warehouse Company has been granted authority, under Section 3666 of the Public Utilities Code, to transport property for S & W Fine Foods and Equitable Cash Grocery at rates less than the established minimum rates. The authority is scheduled to expire May 31, 1957.

Hearings in this matter were held March 29 and April 29, 1957. On the latter date the application was submitted on briefs to be filed thirty days after the filing of the transcript. It appears that briefs will not become due until on or about the expiration date of the applicant's present authority.
