OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 51988 of September 27, 1955, in Application No. 37122, authorized applicant to lease one of two buildings used in his public utility warehouse operations conducted at Stratford to Continental Grain Company for private storage. The lease expired May 31, 1957. Applicant seeks an extension of this authority for a further one-year period.

In the circumstances it appears that the proposed extension of the lease should be authorized. A public hearing is not necessary. The supplemental application will be granted. In view of the expiration date of the former authority the following order will be made effective immediately.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that C. H. Fowler, doing business as C. H. Fowler Warehouse and Elevator, may, on the effective date of this order, lease the warehouse property involved in this proceeding to Continental Grain Company, a corporation, as requested.

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
