INTERIM SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Applicant holds a city carrier permit. Prior orders in this proceeding have authorized it, under Section 4015 of the Public Utilities Code, to deviate from the established minimum rates in connection with specified San Francisco drayage operations. It is authorized to transport flour for Langendorf United Bakeries, Inc., in quantities of not less than 50,000 barrels per calendar year at a rate of 16 cents per hundred pounds, and newsprint paper, in rolls, for Hearst Publications, Inc., in quantities of not less than 35,000 tons per calendar year at a rate of \$1.50 per ton. The authority is scheduled to expire June 5, 1957. By this supplemental application, authority is sought to continue to deviate from the minimum rates for a further one-year period.

The supplemental application states that the conditions which justified deviations from the minimum rates generally still obtain; that the authorized rates have been and are compensatory; and that operations under the proposed rates may reasonably be expected to be profitable for the ensuing year. However, the supplemental application does not contain information to substantiate the alleged profitableness of the rates under existing conditions.


The authority will be extended for a 90-day period to enable applicant to submit further evidence. Inasmuch as the present authority expires June 5, 1957, the order will be made effective on that date.


Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted to Walkup Drayage and Warehouse Company by Decision No. 53206, dated June 12, 1956, in 12th Supplemental Application No. 20520, be and it is hereby extended to September 3, 1957, unless sooner canceled, changed or further extended by order of the Commission.


This order shall become effective June 5, 1957.
