OPINION AND ORDER

Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, by the aboveentitled application filed April 16, 1957, seeks authorization of this Commission to carry out the terms of an agreement, to become effective for a one year period commencing February 1, 1957, with Karl G. Wollarth and Helen V. Wollarth, his wife, permitting them to take not to exceed 45 gallons of water per minute of surface flow from Sisar Creek, a tributary of Santa Paula Creek, for the purpose of maintaining fish in ponds located on certain land described in the application.

The price to be paid for the right to take water is \$5 at the time of execution of the agreement and \$5 per month until the expiration of the agreement which is fixed as January 31, 1958, unless extended by the exercising by the Wollarths of annual options granted them by the agreement at the times and in the manner therein specified. The agreement, by its terms, is to automatically terminate in the event the Wollarths cease to occupy and use the land described in the application.

the Commission by the terms of the agreement.

The agreement limits the amount of water to be taken by the Wollarths to the flow of Sisar Creek, and they agree that such water taken will in no event be used for human consumption.

The land is located above applicant's distribution system. 3/ Each such annual extension must have the consent and approval of

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the application should be granted and that a public hearing is not necessary; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Santa Paula Water Works, Ltd., a corporation, is authorized to carry out the terms and conditions of the agreement with Karl G. Wollarth and Helen V. Wollarth, his wife, as set forth in Exhibit A attached to this application, which exhibit is hereby made a part of this order by reference.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall:

- 1. File with this Commission within thirty days after the effective date of this order two certified copies of the agreement as executed together with a statement of the date on which the agreement is deemed to have become effective.
- 2. Notify this Commission of the date of termination of said agreement within thirty days from and after said date of termination.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
