O P I N I O N

Willig Freight Lines, presently rendering service as a highway common carrier in an area from Rockport and Fort Bragg, on the north, and the San Francisco Bay area, on the south, requests authority to extend service to the Greenwood Construction Camp of the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, located 11 miles northwest of Philo, and to operate over an unnumbered County highway between Boonville and Point Arena, as an alternate route.

As justification for the authority sought it is alleged that the Pacific Gas and Electric Company proposes to establish the Greenwood Construction Camp within the next thirty days, and that the proposed alternate route would be for operating convenience only.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary. Because the camp will soon be established the effective date of this order will be the date hereof.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Willig Freight Lines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of a service as a highway common carrier, as defined in Section 213 of the Public Utilities Code for the transportation of general commodities except used, uncrated household goods, liquids, automobiles and articles of extraordinary value between all points which it is presently authorized to serve, on the one hand, and the Greenwood Construction Camp of the Pacific Gas and Electric Company, located 11 miles northwest of Philo, on the other hand.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective appropriate tariffs.
- (c) In providing service pursuant herein authorized applicant shall operate over the following route:

Unnumbered County Road between State Highway No. 28 and State Highway No. 1 at Elk; unnumbered County Road between Boonville and Point Arena as an alternate route.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
