Application of PACIFIC GREXHOUND IINES
for authority to operate as a passenger stage corporation over relocated California Highway 24 between junction of present California تinghway 24 and Upper Happy Valley Road and junction of prosent Califormia Highway 24 and Pleasant Hill Road.

## QEINTON

Pacific Greyhound Iincs seeks authority from the Comaission to operate as a pessenger stafe corporation, over relocatcd California Highway 24 between its jurction with Upper Eappy Valley foad west of Lafayette and its junction with pleasant Hill Road east of rafaycte. Applicant also proposes that certain technical revisions, comections and substitutions to Appendix A of Decision No. 47907 be madc in route descriptions in the west Contra Costa County area as hereinafter expleined.

Specifically the authority requested is to revise the following routes in the following maner:
(1) Route No. 11.02

Applicant's present Routc No. 21.02 inciudes in its route description the designation of California Highway 24 between the point designated as Hapy Valley junction and the point designated as ileasent Lill Overpass. This is $a$ segment of the direct route of applicant's operations between Oakiand and Concord and points beyond. In order to adopt relocated California Highway 24 as a part of this regular route as nerein requested, no change in route description is necessitated. Insteed, 211
that is required is the change in the date of issuance of such authority in order that the highway designation "Cailifornia Highway $24^{n}$ may refer to the highwey route which is so numbered at the time the operatinc authority herein requested is issued. Applicant proposes to operatc over the new highway between the aforementioned points on through schedules only.
(2) Route No. 11.15

Applicant states it has no intention of abandoning its present route of operation between Eappy Valley Junction and Pleasant Hill Overpass over former Califomic Highway 24 via Lafayette but, instead, desires to retain said route for locil operations which serve such area. Authority is requested, therefore, to concurrently reissue the present operating authority between the concerned points to the cxtent that such highway route will no longer be numbered California Highway 24. It is therefore proposed that a new route to be numbered 22.25 be added to said Appendix A to Decision No. 47907 to serve this purpose.
(3) Route No. 21.05

Since the construction of an overpass structure at the junction of Pleasant Hill Road and Colifomia Highvey 24 at a point heretofore designated in applicant's operating authority as Acalanes Junction, such point has becone comonly known as Pleasant Hill Orerpass, and appicant states it is desirable that the latter name be applied to this point and thet its route number 11.05 be revised accordingly.
(4) Route No. 21.09

In the route description of applicant's Route No. 11.09 roads over which operations are authorized are designated
"Donovan Road", and "harsh Creek Road". Applicant alleges that currently published maps no longer indicate such road names but, instead, these roads are designoted "Kirker Pass Road" and "Clayton Rad", respectively. Kiriken Fass Road connects with Railroad Avenue south of Pittsburg. Applicant therefore proposes that its Route No. 21.09 be zevised accordingly.
(5) Route No. 39 General Authorization in

Applicant also proposes that the route description of Route No. 39 as presently shown in general authorization $K$, Original Page 102 of said Appendix A to Decision No. 47907, should be revised in order to have the same correctly worded in accordance With the current record. Applicant states that this routc description requires correction, without change in authorization, because Of inadvertence. Decision No. 52106, dated October 16, 1955, it is illeged, cleanily intcnded to authonize the operation of oversized vehicles between Viartinez and Acalanes Junction. On April 27, 1955, Application No. 36916 was filed seeking a change in the description of the segment of Route No. 21.05 lying between Jartinez Junction and Acelanes Junction, and a corresponding change in the route description of the aforesaid route of over-sized bus operation was aiso requested. Decision No. 52107 granted this application except that the revised route of over-sized bus operation failed to include the previously authorized sezment between Vartinez and jartinez Junction while revising the route description betweon Martinez Junction and acalanes Juaction.

As justification for the authorivy sought applicant alleges that California Eighway 24 has been relocated and reconstructed over a new amd nore direct route between the points herein
designated. As a result this highway will by-ipass the point of Lafayette and the route of former California Highway 24 between Happy Valley Junction and Pleasant $\operatorname{dill}$ Overpass will become an unnumbered county highway. This former highway 24 through Iafayette has been in the past extrenely congested, especially during the early morning and late afternoon hours and it is to relieve this traffic congestion as well as to eliminate accident hazards amising from road intersections at grade that California ifighway 24 has been relocated and reconstructed in the area here concerned. It provides a modern limited-access highway with four traffic lans and having the east- and west-bound lanes divided with a 40-f00t separation, and, it is alleged, will provide a safe and fast routc. The applicant states that said relocated higinay will be completed and opened for travel on or about June 6, 1957.

While the authority sought is for the establishment of a "regular routel with porission to serve all intermediate points, applicant does not proposc to stop its buses for the receipt or discharge of passengers, baggage or express at any point on any freeway of any limited-access highway where such would be in violation of applicable lews, or of rules or regriations proviece by governmental authority, or in any other instance where it would not be safe for applicant:s passengers or for the generaj traffic moving on the highway.

No changes in fares or rates are proposed. The current tariffs of applicant applicable to fares, rates and charges for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express, together With the rules and restuations governing the same, will continue to apply. No new fare points are proposed to be served.

After consideration the Comission is of the opinion and so finds that public convonience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. is public hearing coes not appear to be necessary.

Application having beon filed and the Comission having been fully informed therein, and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS OIDERED:
(1) That a certificate of pubiic convenience and necessity is hercby granted to Pacific Greyhound Iines, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express, weighing 200 pounds or lees, between Happy Valley junction and Pleasant $\#$ ill orempass over relocated Califomia Highway 24. Authority is grented to operate "motor coaches of excess length and widthi, as that tem is defined in section 3 (N) of Appendix A, over Route No. 39, general authorization Ne, as described on First Revised Page 202, of said kppendix A.
(2) That Appendix is of Decision No. 47907 is hereby amenced by jncorporating Second Revised Page 29 in revision of First Revised Page 29, Second Revised Fage 30 in revision of First Revised Page 30, Fourth Revised Page 31 in revision of Thire Revised Page 3l, First Revised Page 102 in revision of Original Page 102 and Second Revised Page 101 in revision of First Revised Rage 201. The revised pages arc hereby cancelled.
(3) That the authority herein granted is an extension and enlargement of, and consolidation with and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 47907 and in particular subject to the provisions set forth in Section 3 of Appendix a thereof.
(4) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
(a) Within thirty dave after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
(b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not lose than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, appropriate tariffs and timetables which shall be satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shell be the date hereof.
