ORDER

San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across 31st Street, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 36D-2.8, and across and along Commercial Street, to be identified as Crossing No. 36D-2.82-C, in the City of San Diego, San Diego County, at the locations described in the application. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation, and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding two per cent.

Protection at Crossing No. 36D-2.8 shall be by one existing Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B) and protection at Crossing No. 36D-2.82-C shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Applicant is authorized to deviate from the requirements of Section 3.17 of General Order No. 26-D in so far as it relates to the regularly established line for construction of the future curb, provided that all other clearances created in the future shall comply with the provisions of that general order.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
