ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to relocate two spur tracks at grade across 65th Street and to relocate one spur track and to construct an additional spur track at grade across 66th Street in the City of Emeryville, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings No. A-7.75 and A-7.82, respectively. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one percent. Protection shall be by existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B). Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or

safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
