O R D E R

The County of Ventura is authorized to construct Santa Ana Boulevard at grade across the Ojai Branch of Southern Pacific Company in the County of Ventura, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. BAE-406.7. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 38 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Upon completion, Crossing No. BAE-406.6 and the publicly used crossing about 70 feet southwesterly of the new crossing location shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year,

unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
