By their petition for modification it is requested that Route E be amended to provide service over 16th Avenue between Grant Street and Delaware Street in the City of San Mateo.

As justification for the authority sought it is alleged that the City of San Mateo objects to the existing route via Betty Lane, Wolfe Drive, Connie Avenue and Charles Lane, which are narrow streets only 34 feet in width.

- Route H. Beginning at Third Avenue and B Street, thence via B Street, 4th Avenue, El Camino Real, Hillsdale Boulevard, Pacific Boulevard, 39th Avenue, Pasadena Drive, Santa Clara Way, Saratoga Drive, Hillsdale Boulevard to Pacific Boulevard.
- Route I. Beginning at Third Avenue and B Street, thence via B Street, 4th Avenue, El Camino Real, Hillsdale Boulevard, Edison Street, 37th Avenue, Alameda de las Pulgas, Ralston Avenue, El Camino Real to Hillsdale Boulevard.

Applicants are authorized to turn their vehicles at termini and intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections of streets or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection, or in accordance with local traffic rules.
