ORDER MODIFYING DECISION NO. 52007

Decision No. 52007, in ordering paragraph 10, requires Alfred E. Augenstein and Mary Z. Augenstein, doing business as Buckingham Park Water System, to install automatic water level controls at their storage tanks and to notify the Commission in writing of the completion of such installation within 15 days thereafter.

By formal petition filed on May 13, 1957, applicants request modification of the subject decision to delete the requirement for installation of the automatic water level controls. It is alleged that the water service furnished to all customers is now metered with the result that water use has decreased to the extent that automatic controls are not now considered necessary, the system growth is small, present operating methods are providing satisfactory service, and the expenditure of funds for such controls at this time under these circumstances appears unwarranted. The staff of the Commission has investigated the matter, concurs in the allegations made by the applicants and recommends that the relief sought be granted. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 52007 is modified by deleting therefrom ordering paragraph 10.

Except as herein modified, Decision No. 52007 shall in all other respects remain in full force and effect.
