The respondents point out that this particular operation was not involved in the investigation upon which the suspension order was predicated. Upon consideration of the petition and of the evidence, in this proceeding, and good cause appearing, IT IS CRDERED that ordering paragraphs Nos. (2) and (5) of Decision No. 55088, in this proceeding shall not be applicable to the transportation of cement from Monolith to Bakersfield. -1-
