FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 55088, dated June 4, 1957, in this proceeding, the Commission ordered, among other things, that the operating authority under any and all permits issued to the respondents be suspended for a period of five days beginning at 12:01 a.m. on the first Monday following the effective date of said decision.

The respondents have petitioned for modification of the order insofar as it would be applicable to the transportation of cement from Monolith to Bakersfield. The respondents point out that this particular operation was not involved in the investigation upon which the suspension order was predicated.


Upon consideration of the petition and of the evidence, in this proceeding, and good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that ordering paragraphs Nos. (2) and (5) of Decision No. 55088, in this proceeding shall not be applicable to the transportation of cement from Monolith to Bakersfield.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects said Decision No. 55088 shall remain in full force and effect.


This decision shall be effective on the date hereof.
