ORDER RELIEVING APPLICANT OF FILING CERTAIN REPORTS

Applicant has made written request that the Commission amend its Decision No. 43145, dated July 26, 1949, to cancel the requirement that it file quarterly reports showing the percentage of intrastate toll messages overtimed more than five seconds.

Applicant has filed such reports with the Commission beginning with the quarter ending December 31, 1949, and quarterly thereafter. These reports have served their purpose and it appears to the Commission that the request should be granted; therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company on and after the effective date of this order, is relieved from the requirement of filing quarterly reports with the Commission showing the percentage of messages overtimed more than five seconds as required by the fourth ordering paragraph of Decision No. 43145, dated July 26, 1949, in the above numbered application.

In all other respects Decision No. 43145 is unmodified by this order.
