FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By its petition filed on June 5, 1957, Suburban Water Systems, formerly known as San Jose Hills Water Company,^{1/} a corporation, seeks an order modifying Decision No. 54532, dated February 11, 1957, in Application No. 34829. By said decision, the Commission required Suburban, among other things, to file four copies of a comprehensive map of its San Jose Hills District drawn to a scale not smaller than 300 feet to the inch.

The petition states that Suburban maintains comprehensive maps drawn to a scale of one inch equals 600 feet, and requests^{2/} that it be permitted to file such maps in substitution for the scale ordered by the subject decision. An extension of time for the filing of these maps is also requested.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the request should be granted, and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Paragraph 9 of Decision No. 54532, dated February 11, 1957, be and it is modified by deleting the wording "300 feet to the inch" and substituting therefor
