THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By its petition filed on June 5, 1957, Southwest Water Company,^{1/} a corporation, seeks an order modifying Decision No. 54327, dated December 27, 1956, in Application No. 37413. By this decision, the Commission required Southwest, among other things, to file four copies of a comprehensive map drawn to a scale not smaller than 600 feet to the inch.

The petition herein states that Southwest maintains comprehensive maps drawn to a scale of one inch equals 2,000 feet and requests that it be permitted to file such maps in substitution for the scale ordered by the subject decision. An extension of time for filing of these maps is also requested.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant and being of the opinion that the request should be granted, and that a public hearing is not necessary, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that paragraph 5 of Decision No. 54327, dated December 27, 1956, be and it is modified by deleting the wording "600 feet to the inch" and substituting

therefor "2,000 feet to the inch". Further, the time allowed for filing of the said comprehensive maps is hereby extended to and including ten days after the effective date of this third supplemental order.

In all other respects, except as specifically modified hereby, Decisions Nos. 54327, 54697 and 55000 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
