

OPINION AND ORDER

This is an application for an order authorizing Star and Croscent Boat Co. to transfer its operative rights and assets upon liquidation and dissolution to Oakley J. Hall, its sole shareholder.

The corporation has been engaged in the operation of service as a common carrier of passengers by vessel on San Diego Bay. Earlier this year, its sole shareholder undertook to wind up and dissolve its affairs and caused the transfer to him of all the corporation's assets and business upon surrender of the outstanding shares for cancellation. The proceeding indicates that the transaction has not and will not result in any diminution or interruption of service to the public and upon the basis of the verified application, we are of the opinion and so find, that the proposed transfer is not adverse to the public interest and should be approved by an ex parte order; therefore,

IT IS HEREBY URDERED as follows:

1. That Star and Crescent Bost Co., upon its liquidation and dissolution, may transfer its certificate of public convenience and necessity and its assets to Oakley J. Hall.

2. On not less than one day's rotice to the Commission and to the public, applicants shall join in common supplement to the tariff on file with the Commission in the name of Star and Crescent Boat Co. to show that Star and Crescent Boat Co. has withdrawn or canceled and that Oakley J. Hall concurrently has adopted or established as his own said rates, rules and regulations. The tariff filings made pursuant to this order in all respects shall comply with the Commission's Tariff Circular No. 2.

3. This order is effective on the date hereof.
